



















### 2. Assembly side panel



Note: Lift up the rear door before sliding the side panels into the side roof frame









# 9. Install the canopy on truck bed




- A MINIMUM OF FOUR PEOPLE ARE RECOMMENDED TO PICK UP AND PLACE THE CANOPY ONTO THE TRUCK.
- TO KEEP FROM DAMAGING YOUR D-RUBBER DURING THE INSTALLATION PROCESS, IT IS IMPORTANT YOU LIFT THE CANOPY IN PLACE AND DO NOT DRAG IT ACROSS THE TRUCK BED RAILS.
- ONCE THE CANOPY IS CENTERED, PLACE CLAMPS IN POSITION.




### LED INTERIOR LIGHT


Plug the provided Interior Light Harness at the connector coming from the rear driver side of the topper (Fig A).

Tuck the harness into the topper using the rubber grommet (Fig B). The other end of the harness will need to go
to the vehicle's battery. Route the harness underneath the vehicle, make sure to avoid any moving parts or exhaust components.

An auxiliary light and key set are include in the packaging.
